



Covid 19 Temporary Measures at Agios Georgios

The purpose of this document is to set out the temporary measures to be applied for Club sailing at Agios Georgios during the Covid 19 situation.

The objective of these GUIDELINES is:

1. To comply with all pertinent government regulations
2. To safeguard all participants in official PISC sailing activities. (Sailors, OOD, Patrol Boat and Beach Crews).

PLEASE NOTE. THE MANAGEMENT BOARD CANNOT STRESS ENOUGH THE IMPORTANCE OF ADHERING TO THESE GUIDELINES. ANY BREACHES OF THESE GUIDELINES COULD HAVE VERY SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES FOR THE CONTINUATION OF SAILING ACTIVITIES.

IF YOU ARE SHOWING ANY SYMPTONS, HOWEVER SLIGHT THAT COULD BE COVID 19 PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND. IF YOU DEVELOP ANY SYMPTONS AFTER A SAILING SESSION PLEASE SEEK MEDICAL ADVICE AND ALSO NOTIFY THE REAR COMMODORE SAILING IMMEDIATELY.

1. Contact tracing:

- a) Prior to arrival at A.G ALL participants or visitors are requested to send an email to: attendance.pisc@gmail.com
- b) This email can be sent on the day or earlier.
- c) The email should contain the following:
 - i. Name, phone number, date attending (and nothing else).
- d) The purpose of this exercise is to give us definitive contact list in the case of a Covid 19 incident.

2. Car parking:

- a) Please keep a 2m space between cars

3. RIB Shed:

- a) The only people who should enter the RIB Shed and surrounding area before, during and after sailing are the following:
 - i. RCS, OOD, Patrol Boat Cox and Crew, Beach Crew
 - ii. Individuals may be specifically requested to enter this area, by the OOD to assist with tasks such as pushing the Patrol Boat back into the shed
- b) Hand washing facilities including sanitizer will be provided at the RIB Shed for the above named personnel.
- c) Disposable gloves, if required are available at the RIB Shed for the above named personnel.

4. Dinghy park:

- a) Please maintain social distancing between different boat crews.
- b) If there are more than 10 people in the boat park, please ensure that you do not become one large group.

5. Briefing:

- a) There will be no group briefing. The OOD will circulate around the boat park, take down the details of boat and crew, collect the sailing fees and brief them on the days activities.

i. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE THE CORRECT MONEY. NO CHANGE WILL BE GIVEN.

6. Launching:

- a) Prior to launching please space the boats at least two metres apart.**
- b) Only one boat at a time on the ramp.**
- c) Boat crews should park the launching trolley.**
- d) Beach crew maintain social distancing as much as is feasible.**
- e) Hand sanitiser to be available at the launching ramp for beach crew to use between launching boats.**
- f) Disposable gloves to be available for the beach crew prior to commencement of launching.**

7. Landing:

- a) No boat should land until the previous boat has been moved off the launching ramp.**

8. Wash down area:

- a) Boats waiting for the wash down facilities should be at least two metres apart.**
- b) Prior to handling the hoses the boat crews must use the hand sanitiser which will be available at the wash down area.**
- c) After use and before passing the hose to the next person please rinse the nozzle in the bucket of disinfectant that will be provided.**

9. Post sailing sanitisation:

- a) All boat crew life jackets should be dunked in a large vat which will contain a weak antiseptic solution and then thoroughly hosed down.**
- b) All buoys, anchors etc. Should be hosed down.**
- c) The Cox and crew should wipe down all of the surfaces on the RIB where physical contact is made with antiseptic.**
- d) OOD should wipe down the plastic flag handles with antiseptic solution.**
- e) The driver should wipe down all of the surfaces on the towing vehicle where physical contact is made with antiseptic.**

10. Dinghy Park Post Sailing

- a) After de-rigging their boats crews are requested to disperse.**
 - i. We do not want to have a large group of people milling about in a high visibility area.**

11. Miscellaneous:

- a) Everyone should bring their own water.**
- b) There are no changing facilities.**
- c) Beverages and food are available from Koula's cafe.**
- d) Toilet facilities are available at Koula's cafe.**
