



Sailing Instructions

PISC Monthly Series

These Sailing Instructions **must** be read in conjunction with the PISC Seasonal Series Sailing Instructions.

The PISC Monthly Series is run in conjunction with the PISC Seasonal Series on each Saturday of the month. All Sailing Instructions from the Seasonal Series, as amended from time to time, are included herein by reference. Where instructions in the Monthly Shield Series differ, they are stated below by paragraph number, and replace the paragraph of the same number in the Seasonal Series.

5. Racing Format

- a) The Monthly Series will consist of 12 separate series, each lasting one calendar month, for the period from 1st January to 31st December.

16. Scoring

- c) Competitors who are required by the Rear Commodore Sailing (RCS) to perform beach or safety duty will be scored average points of their non discarded race points in that Series. The maximum number of days of race duties will be one per Monthly Series, unless a concession is made on a case by case basis by, and at the discretion of, the RCS.
- d) Corrected time will be established using a competitor's current Time Correction Factor (TCF) for the entered class of boat. New competitors in any boat class will be allocated an initial TCF by the Rear Commodore Sailing but will not be eligible for the award of prizes until the Monthly Series following completion of three races in that boat class.

20. Prizes

- a) Prizes will be awarded to the first place helm and crew for each calendar month. Where a helm has sailed with more than one crew throughout the month, the crew prize will be awarded at the discretion of the helm.
